Reserve the dates

Saturday 13 May: Around Caux* (2 half-days). Narcissus discovery, lake views & tasting of regional specialities.

Sunday 14 May: Mont-Pèlerin*. Gentle circuit, sweet-smelling narcissi, rich forest & views from Mont Chesau.

Saturday 20 May: Les Pléiades circuit*. Wide meadows of narcissi and exploration of Tenasses marshes.

Sunday 21 May: Blonay-Belvedère-Les Avants**. Climb to panoramic viewpoint; walk down past narcissus fields

Sunday 4 June: Creux du Van circuit**/***. Breathtaking natural rock cirque + ibex and rich flora.

Saturday 17 June (preparation Wed 14 June evening): Introduction to alpine flora (mini-course).

Sunday 25 June (*preparation Thurs* **15 June evening):** Safe hiking: refresh your planning and orientation skills! (*mini-course*).

Sunday 2 July: Illhorn & Schwarzhorn****. Two peaks, views of the 4000ers & geologically interesting Illgraben.

Saturday 30 September: Gastlosen circuit**/***. Long views; jagged limestone cliffs; flowers, marmots, chamois.

Levels of difficulty (1-4*) are explained on my website. All hikes accessible by public transport.

Sign-up and costs

Hikes are part of the "Narcissi in bloom" programme of the Association Narcisses Riviera, supported by tourist taxes and Montreux-Vevey Tourist Office. Guided in French, except 13 May p.m. in English. Costs: 35 fr. for a full day; 20 fr. for a half-day. Advance reservation through Montreux-Vevey Tourisme.

For all other hikes, please contact me via my <u>website</u> or by e-mail to sign up; deadline 20.00 on the Thursday beforehand. Costs: 50 fr. per person, except for Alpine flora and Orientation mini-courses 120 fr. per person.
